The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>Assessing and managing patients arriving in the Emergency Department. This includes exposure to a wide range of ill or injured patients, paediatrics, minor illness and injuries. Opportunities for knowledge and skills acquisition in Emergency Care. You will develop the ability to recognise sick patients and start appropriate management including resuscitation. You will work alongside the multiprofessional ED team as well as liaising with other teams in the hospital and community. You will have opportunities to develop communication skills as well as practical procedures.
